- Each project lasts a minimum of 6 weeks. This means that the first 5/6 weeks will focus on the main subject objectives. After this, it will be followed by one or two weeks on science or another curriculum subject.
- There will be a science investigation in the final weeks, based on the chosen investigation from 'Let's Investigate'.
- There will be an Art day every half term to show progression in skills for all year groups.
- ICT and music can be interwoven into the projects but will also be taught outside of the projects to ensure curriculum coverage.
- RE will be taught as a standalone subject with links to PSHE.
- French (Modern Foreign Language) will be taught as a standalone subject in Key Stage 2
- PE will be taught as a standalone subject across the school (Indoor and Outdoor)
